16-Man-WB3, 8-Man-WB3, 4-Man and 2-Man brackets will be used.

• Girls Only brackets with be in 8-Girl WB3 or 4-Girl Round Robin brackets

- If there is not a minimum of 3 girls in a given grade/weight, they will be bumped into the appropriate age group and weight class
- Girls may enter the girls only brackets OR the age division brackets, but NOT BOTH
- Top 4 wrestlers will be seeded (Seeding criteria on the back of this flver)
- Tables equipped with TrackWrestling clocks.
- Follow the tournament on trackwrestling.com
- 5&6, 7&8, 9&10 & Girls 5-10 Divisions will wrestle on half mats (three 1 minute periods)

11&12, 13&14 & Girls 11-14 Divisions will wrestle on full mats

Three 1.5 minute periods on the championship side & round robin brackets

Three 1 minute periods on the consolation side

Champion will receive a Custom Ring & Trophy, 2nd – 4th is Trophy Only Awards:

Team Trophy for the top TEN team scores (nice walnut team trophies).

Admission Fee: \$5 per person

Concessions available all day. Water & snacks will be available to coaches only. Food:

Format:

Coaches and Spectators can follow on their smartphones at http://trackwrestling.com. Use the Hub button to display your team's bout/mat assignment schedule and brackets quickly.

Please verify that your wrestlers weights have been entered prior to 8:30pm on the 13th and that they appear on a bracket Saturday morning. No changes/additions can be made to the brackets after 7:40am on the 14th.

<u>Seeding Criteria:</u> Seeding will be based off of the wrestler's placement at the following four tournaments and ONLY these four tournaments:

- 2024 O'Fallon Panther Pummel
- 2024 USAW State Championships for your state (no AAU, NuWay, Freestyle or Greco-Roman)
- 2024 Granite City Kids Holiday Classic
- 2025 Belleville Little Devils Open

It is the responsibility of whoever registers the wrestler to enter the placement for the 2024 USAW State.

The seeding points for the O'Fallon, Granite City & Belleville tournaments will automatically be calculated and entered into TrackWrestling.

The tournament director will break ties in seeding points using a coin flip.

If you register early, keep the e-mail confirmation from TrackWrestling which will have a link to go back into your registration later to edit state placement & weight classes up until registration closes.

Seeding Points per Tournament

1 st	20 points
$2^{\rm nd}$	15 points
$3^{\rm rd}$	12 points
$4^{ ext{th}}$	10 points
5 th	8 points
$6^{ ext{th}}$	6 points
$7^{ m th}$	4 points
$8^{ ext{th}}$	2 points
No Place/Participation	1 point

Example: 37 points – 2024 Panther Pummel (1st/20 points), 2024 USAW State (4th/10 points), 2024 Granite City Kids Holiday Classic (Participation/1 point) and 2025 Belleville Little Devils Open (6th/6 points).

Make sure your wrestlers reports to the score table after a win to ensure that the table workers have the correct winner listed. All incorrectly entered bouts must be reported to the head table <u>immediately</u> to be corrected. <u>We will not change an error once the next round has wrestled.</u>

This has become one of the toughest tournaments in the region with wrestlers coming from several different states to include AR, GA, IA, IL, IN, KY, MD, MO, MS, OH, OK, PA, TN, TX, VA & WI. Last year we had over 700 kids register and over a third of those kids were from out of state. We expect to max out at 700 wrestlers again this year. Register early to avoid getting locked out.

Don't forget that we offer a team trophy to the top 10 team scores (nice walnut team trophies). The top 12 scorers from each team will automatically count towards the team's score. Team scores will be calculated at the end of the tournament.

We will also have an Ali Gutierrez Memorial Award for the Outstanding Girl Wrestler in each session

You may change your weight class up until the time registration closes by using the link in the e-mail confirmation from TrackWrestling. After registration closes, there will be no weight class changes, however, those wrestlers who weigh-in heavy will be moved to the next higher weight class at no extra charge.

IKWF bylaws require IKWF sanctioned tournaments to verify both wrestlers and coaches USAW membership to participate. All Illinois wrestlers and coaches must appear on the IKWF website and <u>out of state wrestlers must have their USAW cards available</u> in case what is entered into TrackWreslting does not pass the automatic check. All coaches must sign-in with their <u>USAW card with NCEP Copper or Bronze</u> Certification to receive a wristband that will allow them on the mats.
